Set aside 10–15% extra for hidden surprises like water damage, old plumbing, or wiring.

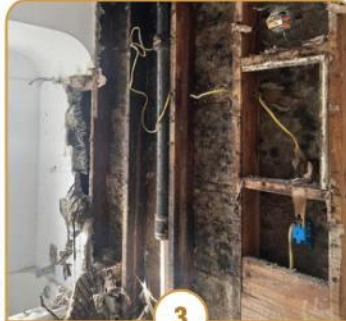

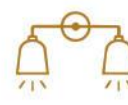

TUB OPTIONS & SIZES

Designed to fit into a bathroom corner, usually with a wider shape for soaking. Best for layouts with extra floor space.



SOAKING TUB

A deeper tub designed for relaxing baths. Available in different shapes and styles, with extra depth for comfort.



FREESTANDING TUB

A standalone tub that does not need to be built into a wall or deck. It creates a clean, open look and often becomes a focal point.



WHIRLPOOL/JETTED TUB

A tub with built-in jets that circulate water for a more relaxing, spa-like bathing experience.

The floor under your shower matters just as much as the tile, fixtures, and glass.

SHOWER PAN OPTIONS



SOLID SURFACE/ CULTURED MARBLE PAN

Manufactured as one piece with the slope and drain location built in.

A clean, low-maintenance option with fewer grout lines and easier cleaning.

VS.

TILE SHOWER PAN

Built on site for greater flexibility in tile design, drain placement, and shower layout.

Proper waterproofing and slope are critical before tile is installed.



CHOOSE YOUR DRAIN



CENTER/POINT DRAIN

A familiar and versatile option that works well with mosaic and smaller format tile.



OFFSET POINT DRAIN

Helpful when the existing plumbing location cannot easily be moved.



LINEAR DRAIN

A long channel drain that can be placed near a wall or within the shower floor for a clean, modern look.

ROUND DRAIN

Classic point drain with a round cover.



SQUARE DRAIN

A clean, modern point drain with a square cover.

3 DETAILS THAT MATTER

WATERPROOFING

Tile and grout are the finish—not the waterproofing. The shower pan, drain, corners, and walls must work together as a complete waterproof system.

PROPER SLOPE

The shower floor must guide water toward the drain. Proper slope helps prevent standing water and low spots.

DRAIN CONNECTION

The drain must connect properly with the waterproofing system to help protect the entire shower.

WE TEST BEFORE & AFTER TILE

FLOOD TEST — BEFORE TILE

1. We plug the drain
2. Fill the shower pan with approximately 2 inches of water
3. We leave it for 24 hours to help confirm the waterproofing and drain connection are working properly

FINISHED SLOPE TEST — AFTER TILE

After the tile is installed, we release marbles across the shower pan to help confirm the finished floor slopes toward the drain and identify any low spots where water could collect.

BUILD RIGHT TIP:

A great-looking shower starts with the details you don't see.

Proper waterproofing, slope, drainage, and testing help protect your bathroom long after the tile is installed.

Adds subtle dimension with angled edges for a polished, more decorative look.

TWO INDIVIDUAL MIRRORS

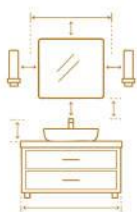
Defines each sink area and leaves room for lighting between or beside the mirrors.

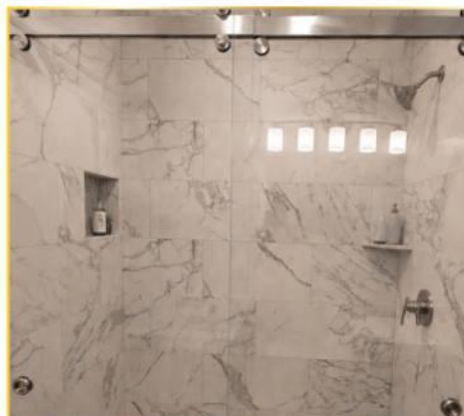
